**Daily Mile** 




Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> April was World Daily Mile Day and so the children have been out running, either around the field or playground, this week, to take part in this.

## Attendance Update



Our average attendance this week was **92.8%**. again!

Our attendance is slowly improving so this term, please can you try to make even more of an effort to ensure that your child attends school every day. As you can see on Twitter and through these newsletters, there are some great topics and activities planned this term, so don't let your children miss out!

If your child's attendance falls below 90%, you will be sent a letter to alert you of this. When we feel it is necessary, home visits will also be arranged. If your child's attendance falls below **96%**, we will require evidence to authorise any further absence. Holidays will not be authorised.

Lateness does also affect your child's attendance. Please try to ensure that your child arrives at school before the gates close, each

morning at **8.40am**.

You can check your child's current attendance using the 'My Child at School App'.

If your child is unable to attend school, please ensure you call or email the school on the morning of **every day** they are absent. The earlier you let us know, the better - thank you.

#### Polling Day

A reminder that on **Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> May**, our small hall is being used as a polling station. The school will still be open to pupils. We have worked closely with the council to fully risk assess the day, which includes having 6-foot cordons in place around the area and additional supervision. The side gate will be closed during school hours, with voters needing to press the buzzer for access, which will be managed by the team. If you wish to see a copy of the risk assessment, please contact the office who can arrange this for you.

As the gate by the small hall is being used for the polling station, please can you make sure you use a different gate on this day to drop off and pick up your children. A reminder also that Chestnut Grove (breakfast and afterschool club) will be closed on this day. If any parents are struggling with before or after school arrangements, please let the office know and we will do what we can to help.



#### **Coronation Plans**



Don't forget, that on **Friday 5<sup>th</sup> May**, we would love you to come and celebrate the King's Coronation with us all. We are having a celebratory afternoon tea, on the school field and are asking the children to come into school wearing something red, white and/or blue.

The school gates will be opened, after the children have finished their lunch break, at **1.50pm**, for you to collect your child from their

classroom, with all their belongings. Teachers will have a register for you to sign the children out. For safeguarding reasons, please inform class teachers, in writing, beforehand, if you give permission for someone else to collect your child, on this day, otherwise teachers <u>will</u> <u>not be able</u> to release your child.

Once you have collected your child, you can make your way to the school field and find a spot to lay out your picnic blanket and set up your afternoon tea. The PTA will be present and information regarding what's on offer can still be found at the bottom of this letter.

The children will all receive some special mementos to remember this historic event, which have been purchased with money kindly donated by Counsellor Placey.

During this event, the younger children will be wearing their newly made crowns and we will be singing some well-known patriotic songs, before finishing with the national anthem. At this point, you may then take your child home.
