The children loved having a visit from our local fire brigade on Monday, morning. They learnt about all the different part of a fire engine and how the fire brigade keeps us safe.







We have a pop-up shop for Father's Day, the fun run (as mentioned above), and the Summer Fete after half term. For dates and times, please see the end of this letter.




