FREE SCHOOL MEALS AND MEAL PRICE INCREASE FROM SEPTEMBER 2023

Don't forget that due to rising costs in all areas of catering, we will be increasing our school meal prices from £2.00 to keep in line with the other schools in the Trust to £2.30, from September 2023.

We have tried to keep the cost down for as long as possible and have succeeded in doing so for an additional six months, however, in order to sustain the excellent quality and quantity of the dinners available, this is a necessary measure.

Remember, if your child will soon be entering Year 3 (Key Stage 2), the Government funded Free School Meals for Key Stage 1 will come to an end, therefore you may wish to check your Free School Meal eligibility. Or if your circumstances have changed and your child is already in Key Stage 2 and you're in receipt of any of the following benefits. A letter with this and more information will have been sent out to you today if you have a child in Y2-Y6. Please contact the office if you have any questions.


Upcoming PTA Events
