Changes to the School Day from September 2023

You may remember that the government brought in a directive for primary schools to be open 32.5 hours a week, as part of the White Paper last year. With changes within the government, the hope was that this may be withdrawn. However, it has now been confirmed that we will need to put this into place. We have thought carefully about how to best manage this and have decided upon the following:

- Keep the morning register time at 8.40am, with the gates opening from 8.30am.
- Extend breaktime for children by 5 minutes to 20 minutes each day.
- Extend lunchtime to 50-minutes each day.
- Finish the day at 3.10pm. We will open the gates at 3.05 to give parents time to get around to the classrooms, with the gates still closing at 3.15pm.

Hopefully these new arrangements will work for everyone, but if there are any concerns, please speak with one of us and we can see what we can do to help. We will review how this is working over September, and if we think anything needs changing at that point, then we will let you know. Thank you for your support and understanding.




