

Dear Parents and Carers.

We have all been so impressed with the way the children have settled straight back into their learning, after the summer holiday.

We have lots of great topics running across the school so make sure your child doesn't miss out on anything, by sending them into school every day. The EYFS topic is called 'All About Me. 
Timings Reminder

Attendance



Here's our first attendance update of the year and it's great news - this week's attendance is 96% which is GOOD. That's a fantastic start to the year - we are getting closer to the top of the ladder!

We will report our attendance figures, in our newsletter each week. If your child is new to the school, please make yourself familiar with our attendance ladder, shown here.

Ensuring your child's regular attendance at school is a parent/carer's legal responsibility (section 444 of the 1996 Education Act) and permitting absence from school that is not authorised by the school creates an offence in law.

Our attendance ladder clearly shows what we expect in terms of good

attendance at school, and our policy informs you further of what happens when attendance falls below certain levels. You can find a copy of our policy on the <u>website</u>.

In summary, if your child's attendance falls below 90%, you will receive a letter to alert you of this and when we feel it is necessary, home visits will also be arranged. If your child's attendance falls below 96%, we will require evidence to authorise any further absence. Holidays will not be authorised.

Lateness also affects your child's attendance so please try to ensure that your child arrives at school before the gates close, each morning at 8.40am. You can check your child's current attendance using the 'My Child at School App'.

Secondary School Applications (Y6 Pupils)

The new secondary school admission round opened on Tuesday, 12 September 2023, for parents and carers of current Year 6 children to apply for a secondary school (Year 7) place for September 2024.

The statutory national closing date for applications is 31 October 2023.



Applications can be made online via www.essex.gov.uk/admissions (99% of applications, last year were made online). The website also has a copy of the Secondary Education in Essex 2024-25 booklet which contains details of all secondary school admission policies.

Clacton Coastal Academy Open Evening (Y6 Pupils)



If you have a child, who is currently in Year 6, you are invited to an open evening at Clacton Coastal Academy, where you will be able to find out what the school can offer your children in Year 7.

The open evening is on Thursday 28th September between 5pm and 7.30pm. There are two separate time

slots available for parents and carers to attend the headteacher's welcome talk at 5.15pm and 6.15pm. After the welcome talk, you will have the opportunity to walk around the Academy and meet various departments and members of staff. There will be science experiments, sporting and musical activities. You will also have the opportunity to taste the excellent food, prepared by the school's caterers.

Pupil Premium Entitlement Reminder

All Foundation Stage and Key Stage 1 children are entitled to Universal Free School Meals, so for the first few years of their school life, school meals are free. As well as this, families who receive certain benefits may be eligible for additional funding called **Pupil Premium**, which is used to support the children in school academically, towards trips, school uniform and clubs.

Your child would be eligible for this funding, if you receive any of the following benefits:

- Universal credit with an annual income of no more than £7,400 (after tax and before benefits)
- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guarantee element of Pension Credit
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for the four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit) with an annual income of no more than £16,190



If you think your child could be eligible for this additional funding, please do contact the school office and we will be very happy to help you with the application form.

School Dinner Payment

If your child is in Years 3-6, you would like them to receive a school meal and they are not eligible to Pupil Premium, please ensure that there is sufficient credit in their dinner account, which is accessed through your 'My Child at School' app. The cost of a school dinner is £2.30 per day. If you have any problems with accessing this app or payments, please pop into the office and we will be happy to help.



£10 Supermarket Voucher

Enable East are running a free workshop to help parents and carers tackle the cost-of-living crisis. The session is on **Wednesday 27th September from 10am-2.30pm**, at Imperial House in Clacton. Every person attending will receive a £10 supermarket voucher. Please see the bottom of this letter, for more information.

Healthy Snacks Reminder

You are very welcome to send your child into school each day with a 'healthy snack' for them to eat at break time and we encourage you to send them in everyday with a drink of water or sugar free squash (no glass bottles).



Please see below the acceptable healthy snacks which have been agreed on as a school:

- plain biscuits, for example, rich tea, digestives
- breadsticks
- fruit (fresh or dried)
- vegetable or salad sticks
- plain rice cakes
- plain crackers

Children in EYFS – Y2 receive a weekly delivery of fresh fruit or vegetables, which they are offered at snack time, each day.


