

Dear Parents and Carers,

Census Day – Thursday 5th October



As I am sure you are aware, funding for schools remains an ongoing challenge nationally. Like many other institutions across the country, we continue to face the impact of rising costs and real term funding reductions.

The vast majority of school funding is driven by the school census, which takes place at key points throughout the academic year. Whilst it might seem easy to simply calculate our pupil led funding based on pupil numbers, calculations are not that straight forward. Part of our funding is based on school meal uptake, particularly in Reception and Key

Stage One, where universal free school meal funding is based on the number of children who actually take a school lunch on the census day.

On **Thursday 5th October**, please help us with this ongoing challenge. If you have a child in EYFS, Year 1 and Year 2 please encourage them to order a school lunch on this day.

To encourage as many children as possible to order a lunch on Thursday 5th October, we are promoting a special '**Burger day' menu**, as we know that burgers are always tend to be a firm favourite of the children. We will be fully loading the salad bar with tortillas, pickles, sauces and burgers toppings and all burgers will be served with curly fries!



Remember that school meals are free for all children in Reception, year 1 and year 2, so ideally, we would love all children to take up this opportunity every day.

Attendance



Our attendance has dipped further from last week to 94.4%. The nasty bug and coughs and colds have continued this week but we are hoping this passes soon and the children can return to school feeling better and ready to continue their learning.

Ensuring your child's regular attendance at school is a parent/carer's legal responsibility (section 444 of the 1996 Education Act) and permitting absence from school that is not authorised by the school creates an offence in law.

If your child's attendance falls below 90%, you will receive a letter to alert you of this and when we feel it is necessary, home visits will also be arranged. If your child's attendance falls below 96%, we will require evidence to authorise any further absence. Holidays will not be authorised. You can find a copy of our policy on the website.

Lateness also affects your child's attendance so please try to ensure that your child arrives at school before the gates close, each morning at 8.40am. You can check your child's current attendance using the 'My Child at School App'.

Secondary School Applications (Y6 Pupils)

The new secondary school admission round opened on Tuesday, 12 September 2023, for parents and carers of current Year 6 children to apply for a secondary school (Year 7) place for September 2024. This is another reminder that **the statutory national closing date for applications is 31st October 2023.** Applications can be made online via www.essex.gov.uk/admissions Mrs Spall and Mrs Levy will be happy to try to help, if you have any questions.

Mrs Smith will be offering tours of the school, to those parents and carers who are interested in applying for a space for their child to start here at Cann Hall with us, next September.



What is Makaton?



Makaton is a system of signs and symbols as used by Mr Tumble on Something Special. Makaton is designed to support spoken language – signs are used with speech, in spoken word order to help children and adults to communicate. It strengthens the development of important communication skills such as attention and listening, comprehension, memory, recall and

organisation of language and expression.

Being able to communicate is one of the most important skills we need in life. Almost everything we do involves communication; everyday tasks such as learning at school, asking for food and drink, sorting out problems, making friends and having fun. These all rely on our ability to communicate with each other.

Using signs can help people who have no speech or whose speech is unclear. Using symbols can help people who have limited speech and those who cannot, or prefer not to sign.

For those who have experienced the frustration of being unable to communicate meaningfully or effectively, Makaton really can help. Makaton takes away that frustration and enables individuals to connect with other people and the world around them. This opens up all kinds of possibilities.


