Tendring Youth Ambassador Programme



As you can see from all of the photographs above, we have lots of fantastic learning opportunities happening in school every day – please don't let your child miss out, if they are well enough to be in school. 3.10pm opening from Monday 9th October



Acting on feedback from parents and carers and school staff, **from Monday 9th October**, we are going to be making a slight change to the time we open the school gates at the end of the day. Instead of opening at 3.05pm we will be opening the gates at **3.10pm** so that the children are ready to be released, as soon as parents and carers arrive. We will then lock the gates at **3.20pm** instead of 3.15pm.


