I am sorry to have to start this week's newsletter with a worrying matter.

On regular occasions, we have had numerous concerns brought to us, by parents and carers and the wider community regarding the safety of our children and families, at drop off and pick up times.

It is being reported to us that certain parents and carers are regularly seen parking and pulling up directly outside the school on the zig zag and double yellow lines, at restricted times, i.e. drop off and pick up times.

It is illegal to park on the zig zag and double yellow lines for good reason and it is especially more important that we all abide by these rules as the darker, wetter mornings and afternoons draw in and visibility is reduced.

So before I move on to celebrate all the wonderful things that have been happening in school this week and before there is an awful accident, **PLEASE**, **PLEASE**, **PLEASE avoid parking outside the school, at these busy times, in the future**. 5HH have been investigating friction by testing vehicles on different surfaces.










Year One Snap Shot

Stefan joined a local football team recently and is already scoring goals. FC Clacton Blues won 11-2 on Sunday.


Well done Stefan, we are all extremely proud of you and look forward to hearing about many more goals to come!


