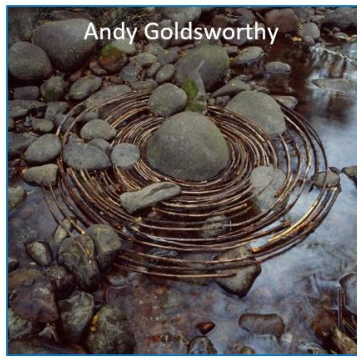

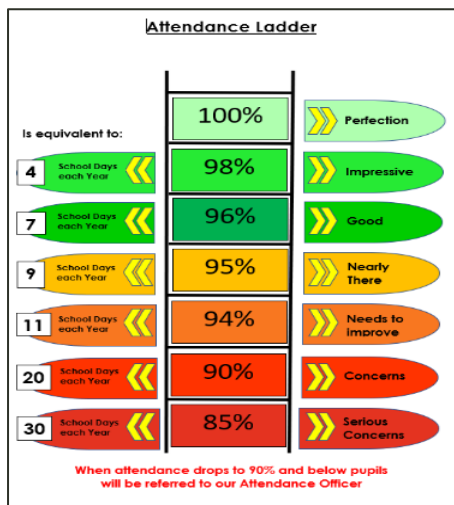




5S have been doing athletics in their PE lessons this term.
