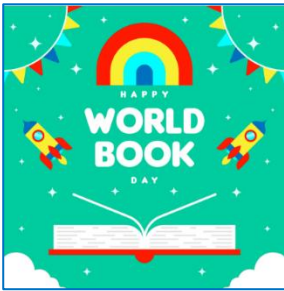

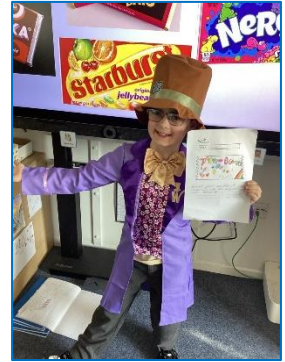

County Lines Intensification Week 2-9th March is a nationally coordinated week of action in the UK, where police forces, regional organised crime units, and partner agencies intensify enforcement, safeguarding and disruption activity against county lines drug networks.

This will include: targeted arrests, closure of deal lines, drugs/cash/weapon seizures, safeguarding of exploited children and vulnerable adults, community engagement and prevention work.

- Secretive or worrying changes in behaviour
- Unknown adults around a young person
- Increased secrecy about phone or online activity

Clacton Uniform Bank
Nominated by Councillor Gina Placey



This initiative is led by local volunteers committed to ensuring every child has access to school uniform, regardless of financial circumstances. They operate through donations of new and pre-loved uniforms from local schools and businesses, including Morrisons, Tesco, and Asda. Additional support has come from tradespeople, retailers, and charities who contributed resources to refurbish their shop. Grant funding has been provided by the Love Essex Fund, Essex Community Foundation, and the National Lottery.

Founded in 2022, the group initially recycled 150-200 items per month. Since relocating to larger premises on St Johns Road in August, they have rehomed over 4,500 items in just two months.

Access to school uniform helps children feel included, reduces bullying, and fosters a sense of belonging. The volunteers collect and distribute clothing, shoes, stationery, and lunchboxes—saving thousands of items from landfill. They also participate in community events to raise awareness and funds, making a significant impact on local families. From opening one day a month, they now operate five days a week. Families value the opportunity to donate and receive items, creating a cycle of support that benefits the entire community. If you have a few hours to spare, volunteering with them can make a real difference.
