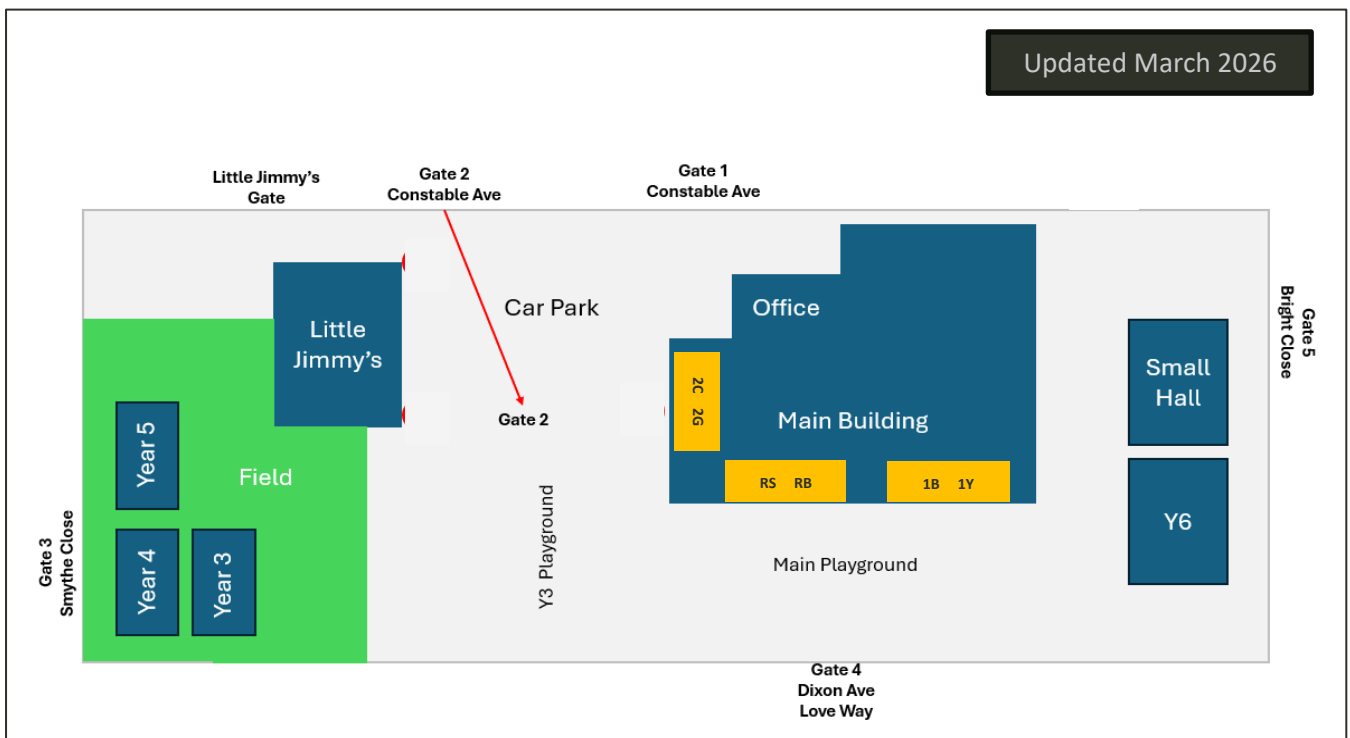

RAAC Roof Project Update

We are delighted that the second phase of the roof project is nearly complete and is due to be handed back to us on the last day of this half term, Friday 27th March. This phase has covered a huge area of the school, with Gipping removing and replacing the roof above the central offices, staff room, the old Year 4 and Year 5 classrooms, the Year 2, 3, 4 and 5 toilets, the SENDCo offices, our sensory and music room and nurture foyer.

Please be aware that if you have a child in EYFS, Year One and Year Two, after the Easter Holiday, your child's classroom will be relocated into our original Year 3, Year 4 and Year 5 classrooms (shown below), in the main building. This move is so that Gipping can start work on the next phase of the project, which is the roof above the current EYFS, Year One and Year Two classrooms.

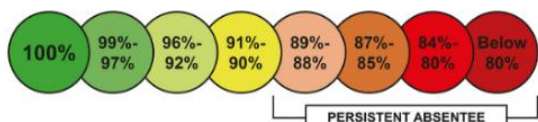

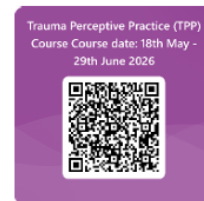
