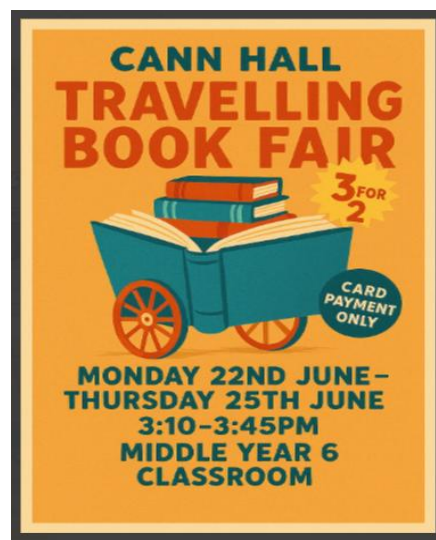

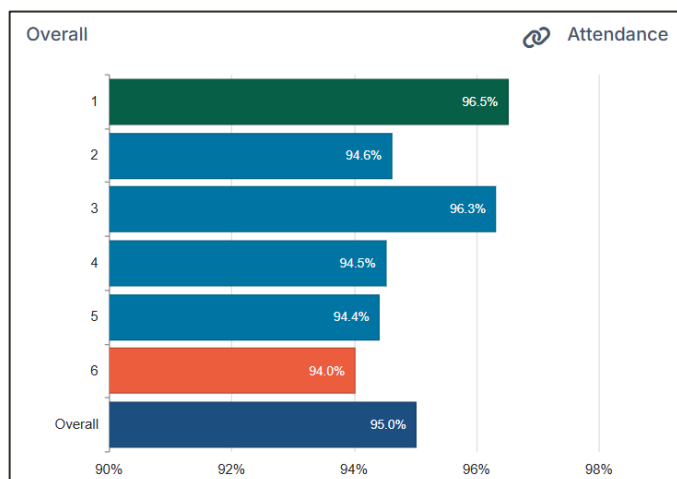
Year 5 sports event will take place at 11.30 – 12.45pm

On **Tuesday 23rd** June there will be a cake sale and soak the teacher outside the Year 6 block, straight after school.

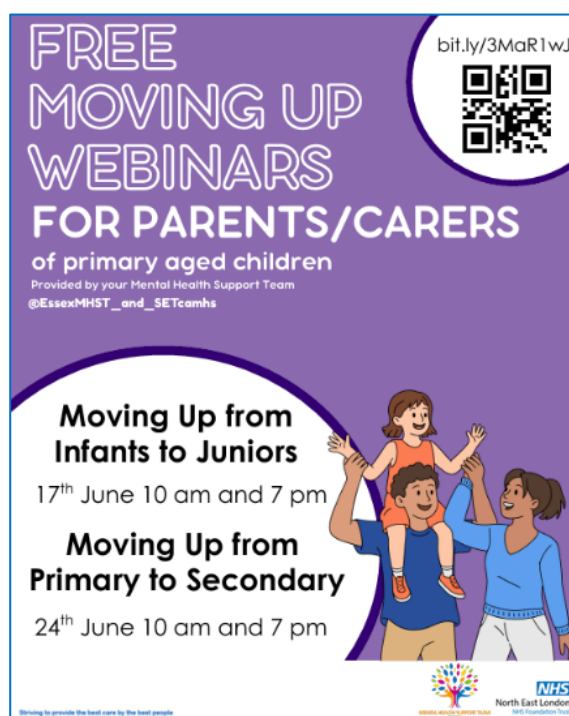


On **Tuesday 30th** June there will be a bric a brac sale outside year 6 block straight after school. All welcome.

They have created human machines, built maps by following verbal instructions and have completed group challenges to earn points for their team.

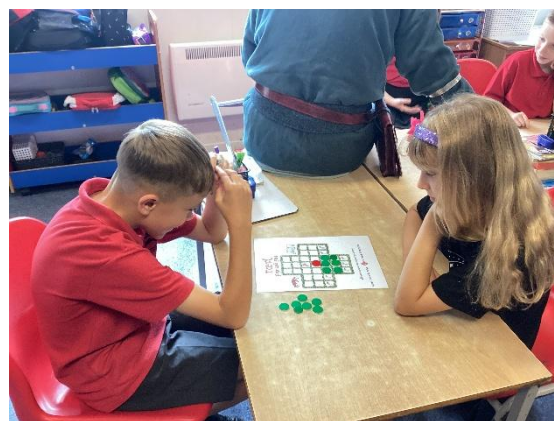


Vikings!
