To further support the children, with a smooth transition, we will have planned two short activities on the afternoon of **Monday 22nd June and Wednesday 24th June**, as follows:

- Story time with my new teacher (30 mins)
- Games with my new teacher (30 mins)

Then our official transition morning will be on Thursday 25th June. This is when the children will spend the whole morning with their new teachers and support staff, in their new class bases.

EYFS, Year 1, Year 2, Year 3, Year 4 and Year 5, are due to start the year, in September, in their current temporary classrooms, due to the on-going roof project. However, our project manager from Gipping is working incredibly hard to try get the current phase of work completed so that the children can start the year in their permanent classrooms. We will of course keep you updated on this throughout the summer break.

Finally, you will have noticed that Miss Young is not on our class structure for next year. This is because she has made the decision to take some time away from teaching to pursue new opportunities, that will allow her to spend more time with her family and friends.



We are extremely sad to be saying goodbye to Miss Young, she has been a wonderful member of the team, always going above and beyond for the children. We know you will join us in thanking her for her dedication and commitment to the school, and we wish her every success and happiness for the future.

You will have also noticed that we are very happy to be welcoming Mrs Argent back from her maternity leave, in September. She will be coming into school for some of the transition activities so she can meet her new class, and they can meet her before September.

We are also very pleased to welcome Miss Ansell, as a class teacher, next year. She trained and qualified as a teacher with us here in 2022/23 and has been working with us this year, supporting classes across the school.

Finally, we warmly welcome Mrs Basye, who has worked here for many years, three of those as a HLTA teaching classes across the school, onto the teaching team.
