When they can, they give them fresh food, but we also like to be able to give them food that lasts a long time, so that they can keep if for when they need it most, for example, dried rice, oatmeal, pasta, long-life milk, tinned fish & meat, tinned soup and tinned vegetables.

Clacton Food Bank are also particularly in need of the following items: **tinned fruit**, **tinned/packet custard**, **long-life milk**, **UHT fruit juice**, **instant mash**, **tinned sponge puddings**, **small jar/packet instant coffee**, **hot chocolate powder**.

We know this year that money is going be even tighter than usual, so if you can manage to send something in with your child to add to our donation table, it will be greatly appreciated.

Timings of the School Day Reminder

The school gates now close five minutes earlier at 8.40am. If you arrive late, after 8.40am,


